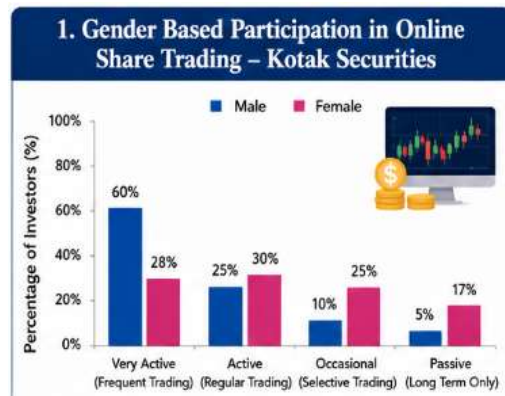

[10] Literature on investor satisfaction reveals that factors such as platform reliability, customer support, transaction speed, research reports, and investment

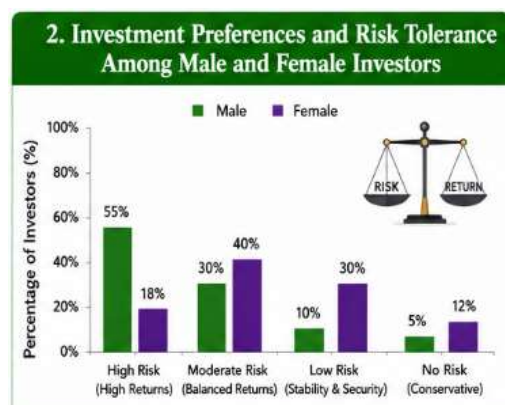
advisory services significantly influence investor trust and long-term usage of online trading platforms like Kotak Securities.

III. DATA ANALYSIS & INFERENCES



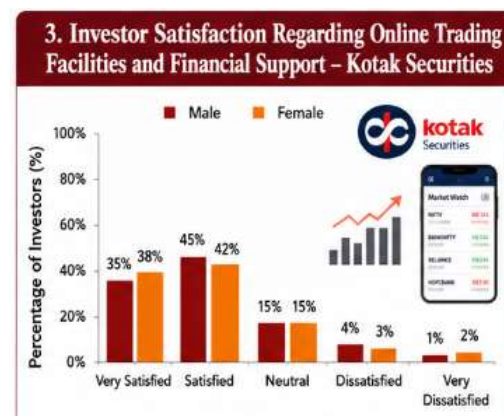
INTERPRETATION:

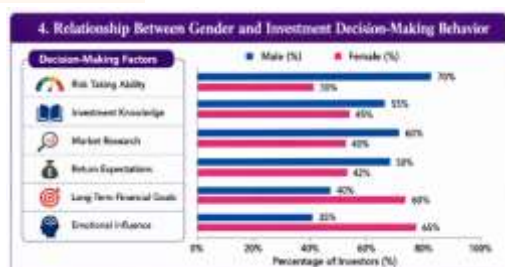
INTERPRETATION:
